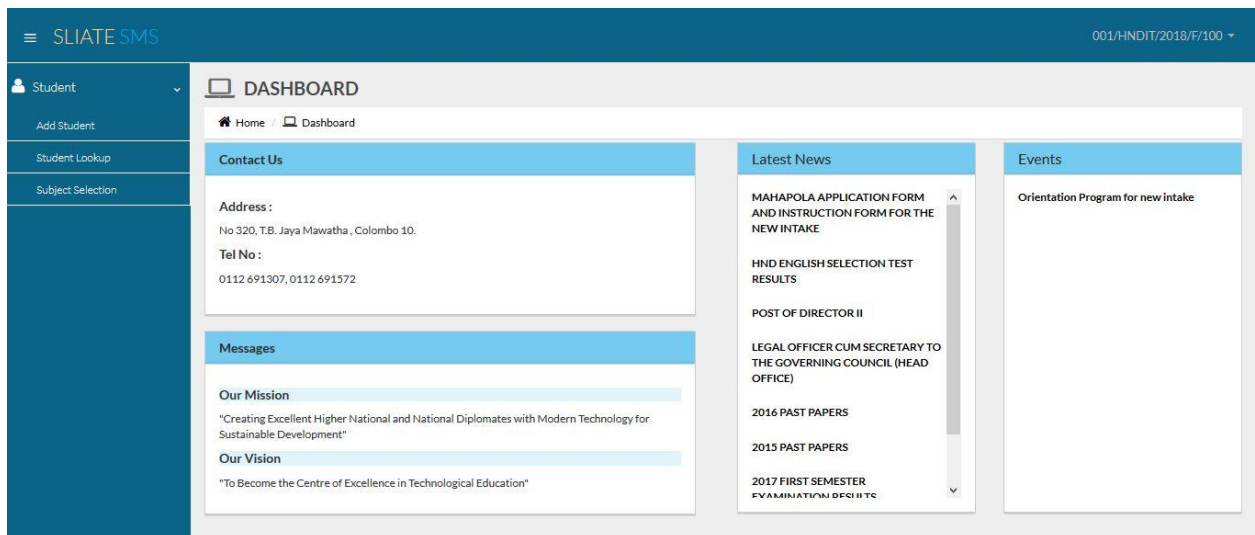


Dashboard

Semester Subjects


After Click on Subject Selection the below dashboard will appear, in there you should click on **Subject Selection Tab**.
